Riesling "Hundertgulden"

Our "personal Großes Gewächs": This Riesling is dense, voluminous and complex, at the same time mineral and salty with ripe yellow and tropical fruit aromas. The grapes come exclusively from the steep southern slope of Appenheim's top location "Hundertgulden", the name of which inspired the drawing on the wine label. Shell limestone from the Tertiary Age characterizes the soil of our oldest vineyard, which is 50 years old.

Due to the exposure in the core location to the south, the incoming midday and evening sun benefits the Riesling in particular, which shows the best assimilation performance in the evening hours. This results in wines with strength that are very salty and digestible due to the shell limestone.

The location appeared on several papal deeds of donation in the Middle Ages. In 1148, Pope Eugene III left the location to the Disibodenberg monastery for use. In 1184 Pope Lucius III transferred the rights of use to the Rupertsberg monastery. The current name of the location dates back to the 14th century, at that time the location changed hands several times and large amounts were paid in Rhenish gold guilders.

Drinking recommendation:

Goes great with strong dishes, tuna, seafood
